

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL INTERLOCAL CONTRACT

CASINO CENTER/3<sup>RD</sup> STREET REALIGNMENT

THIS SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL INTERLOCAL CONTRACT, made and entered into this 19<sup>TH</sup> day of September, 2007 by and between the CITY OF LAS VEGAS, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "CITY" and the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada hereinafter referred to as "RTC".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Regional Transportation Commission approved an Interlocal Contract on August 11, 2005 to design, purchase right-of-way, perform construction inspection and construct roadway improvements and a Supplemental Interlocal Contract dated May 17, 2007 to increase funding and extend the date of completion for Casino Center/3<sup>rd</sup> Street Realignment located wholly within the CITY; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to increase total project funding and receive a revised authorization to proceed.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants, conditions, agreements, and promises of the parties hereto, the RTC authorizes the CITY to proceed with the PROJECT as it is mutually understood and agrees as follows.

SECTION II – PROJECT COSTS shall be revised to read as follows:

The RTC agrees to provide funding for project costs according to Section 6.1 REIMBURSEMENT COSTS of the Policies and Procedures Manual of the RTC within the limits specified below:

1. The total cost for engineering design, contract administration, surveying, inspection, testing, right-of-way engineering, right-of-way negotiations and acquisition, utility

relocation and construction shall not exceed \$10,725,000 which includes all of the above items.

2. A revised "Authorization to Proceed" will be issued for construction at a cost not to exceed \$3,000,000, engineering design at a cost not to exceed \$600,000, right-of-way drawings, descriptions and obtaining appraisals at a cost not to exceed \$125,000 and right-of-way acquisition at a cost not to exceed 7,000,000 at the time written Authorization to Proceed is received from the RTC.
3. A written request must be made to the RTC and an additional supplemental interlocal contract approved to allow exceptions to the adopted policies and procedures of the RTC or the amount noted above prior to payment of any additional funds.

All other terms of the Interlocal Contract dated August 11, 2005 and May 17, 2007 shall remain unchanged.





**PROJECT SUMMARY**  
**CASINO CENTER/3<sup>RD</sup> STREET REALIGNMENT**

**Project:** Casino Center/3<sup>rd</sup> Street Realignment

**Funding:** Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada

**Background:** Project is within the first five years of the Capital Improvement Program. Plans are 90% complete and all right-of-way will be acquired or have right-of-entry prior to bidding this project.

**Existing Conditions:** Casino Center is a four lane between Coolidge Avenue and Charleston Blvd with an 80-foot right-of-way.

**Proposed Improvements:**

**Roadway Improvements:** Realign Casino Center between Coolidge Avenue and Charleston Boulevard to align with 3<sup>rd</sup> Street.-Roadway will be (4) lanes with two of the lanes as future BRT lanes.

**Right-of-Way:** The right-of-way width will be 80-feet.

**Traffic Signals:** A new traffic signal will be constructed at Casino Center and Charleston Boulevard.

**Drainage Improvements:** No new storm drains will be constructed with the project.

**Sanitary Sewer:** No new sanitary sewers will be constructed with the project.
