My name is Mary Kathryn Santos and I am a resident of Ward 6. I am writing today voice my opposition to the following items that will appear on your Wednesday, September 19<sup>th</sup> 2007 agenda:

I would not have heard about this vote if I had not read it recently in the paper. I have come to understand the advance notice postcards were sent to residents within only 2400 feet of this project.

I am opposed to this project for 2 major reasons.

1. The approach to Mt. Charleston, where this proposed project lies, on either side of I-95, creates a critical balance between our cherished protected parks and open lands and the seemingly boundless urban sprawl of our city. When I first moved to Centennial Hills in 2004, this was one of the very reasons I felt this area was so unique and vital. I am sure many residents feel the same way. Centennial is the gateway to an incredibly beautiful part of our valley and we have a duty to protect it. These areas are necessary to create the quality of life all Las Vegas residents should be able to enjoy.
2. Traffic is already a problem, adding the forthcoming huge Megamall project will already burden our roads. The Kyle Canyon Casino and Master plan development will make Centennial Hills no longer the admirable and civically responsible jewel in the Las Vegas crown that it has the potential to be.
