COUNCILMAN REESE called forward STEPHEN HARSIN, Director of Neighborhood Services, DEVIN SMITH, Manager of Neighborhood Response and TONY GUARINO, Code Enforcement Officer II, who was accompanied by WICKI OZUNA, Senior Code Enforcement Officer. COUNCILMAN REESE presented them with a Proclamation declaring October as National Code Compliance Month in recognition of the Code Enforcement Officers for their hard work to keep the neighborhoods safe and clean and educating the community. As the representative of an older ward, COUNCILMAN REESE said he is truly grateful for having the Code Enforcement Division.
