PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On March 2, 2007, an Affidavit of Petitioners' Committee for the purpose of Initiative was filed with the City Clerk's office. On August 17, 2007, an Initiative Petition consisting of one document was submitted by Mr. Lee Wayne Haynes, representing the Petitioners Committee. NRS 295.205.2 requires initiative petitions be signed by a number of registered voters of the city equal to 15 percent or more of the number of voters who voted at the last preceding city election. The document contained one signature and one circulators signature, both names being the same. On August 20, 2007, City Clerk Beverly K. Bridges determined that the petition was insufficient and issued the Certificate of Results of Initiative Petition as insufficient.
