PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

At the regular scheduled Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission meeting held on September 12, 2007, the park naming subcommittee recommended a name for the 44 acre park located at Alexander Road and Hualapai Way. Amenities of the park include 10 softball fields, two playground areas, restrooms and bleachers. The park will be primarily used for girls softball. A vote by the Parks and Recreation Advisory commission was unanimous to recommend the name to City Council for review.
