ACTING CHAIRMAN GOYNES declared the Public Hearing open.

ANDY REED, Planning and Development Department, stated the requested use is compatible with the area and is appropriately located near bus routes. He recommended approval.

ROBIN TAMRAS, 4415 West Spring Mountain Road, Suite 103, appeared on behalf of the applicant.

AL BALISTA appeared on behalf of his wife who owns a business in the subject shopping center and requested clarification of the proposal. GUILLERMO PALERMO, neighboring business owner also requested clarification of the project and the notification postcards.

MARGO WHEELER, Director of the Planning and Development Department, explained that the notification postcards are sent to neighboring businesses and other properties within 1000 feet of the application. She noted that the site requesting the Special Use Permit is listed on the notice postcard.

MS. TAMRAS explained that Women, Infants and Children (WIC) is a federally-funded program which provides women who are pregnant or nursing and children with nutrition counseling and food supplements.

ACTING CHAIRMAN GOYNES informed the neighboring business owners that the applicant's request is a permitted use in that area and that the applicant is required to obtain a Special Use Permit.

ACTING CHAIRMAN GOYNES declared the Public Hearing closed.
