

As a non-occupant homeowner in Las Vegas, I strongly oppose your consideration and possible adoption of the above referenced ordinance set for review at the next City Council meeting on October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2007. This bill would negatively impact tens of thousands of your constituents who currently rent their properties purchased to rent.

I *absolutely agree* that "wild" parties, or "Raves," have no place in any residential area (they have more typically been held in open desert areas per the press and I believe there are already restrictions for holding events such as these). However, I also know that our current city and county laws already provide protection for homeowners from neighborhood disturbances. In addition to LV Metro Police Department, Public Response system is in place to report issues in even areas with no CC&R's in place. There is also a law stating that out of state owners who rent their properties must have a manager or caretaker within 50 miles of the properties! Obviously the attendees and organizers of the offending events in residential areas are subject to arrest for everything from drug use to unlawful assembly.

Any occupant of a property can pose a risk; to wit, longer term tenants and owner-occupants have installed Meth Labs into their garages (putting neighborhoods at extremely high risk); unruly dogs not contained by their owners have attacked and/or killed neighboring pets or children; pool owner's children have tragically drowned while their parents were distracted for a matter of minutes. The point is that disturbances and tragedies happen, and knee-jerk reactions to these events do not help the situation.

Putting over-zealous regulations into place would be out of character for the City Council of such an entrepreneurial and "business-friendly" area such as Las Vegas; also encroaching upon the rights of its constituents (owners whose property taxes pave its roads, school its children and houses its homeless)!

As an owner of a beautiful furnished rental property in Las Vegas which provides comfortable temporary or long term housing (for many casino executives, badly needed housing for teachers and hospital workers, new business owners establishing initial residence, owner-occupied residents who have been displaced by fire or flood, people looking to try our city on "for size" before purchasing a house, etc.), I urge you to consider the huge negative impact this bill would

cause to the property owners in your jurisdiction.

Las Vegas is a unique destination city with a majority of property owners living out of state. I purchased my unit(s) here as an investment in the fast growing city in the country.
