NEIGHBOR CONCERN OVER SDR-25247


My wife and I are native Las Vegans and, with the exception of nine years in the northwest and Summerlin, are lifelong residents of the area in question. Aside from our home in McNeil, where we have lived since 2002, my wife and I own a business in the area. We also own a home in the similar John S. Park neighborhood.

I am writing to voice concern regarding the above-named Site Development Review. While I am not opposed to the development of Charleston Boulevard, I do want the Planning Commission and City Council to carefully consider every request for such development with concern for how it affects the quality of life in the residential neighborhoods just off Charleston. Specifically regarding this request, I am concerned with the following:

- **Parking Encroachment:** there must be plenty of parking available for church attendees to park on site and not in our neighborhood. Such street parking increases traffic and noise pollution, as well as increasing the danger to street activity, which includes children and adults walking, riding bicycles and other outdoor neighborhood activity. These concerns have already forced the closure of Cashman Drive on the north side of Charleston due to the parking encroachment from the Church of Latter Day Saints.
- **Light Pollution:** This SDR presents an issue similar to the problem we now face at Strong Drive, where a newly developed medical office includes several very bright pole lights in the parking lot, causing extreme light pollution for the homes abutting that parking lot. Such lighting should have never been approved as it makes the abutting homes undesirable, which itself has a detrimental effect on the long-term health of the neighborhood. Parking lots must be made safe and secure for the sake of the business and the neighborhood, but without the use of overly bright pole lighting.

I hope that these concerns can be adequately addressed during the SDR.
