

**INTERLOCAL CONTRACT  
BETWEEN  
CLARK COUNTY AND THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS FOR ITS MUNICIPAL COURT  
FEMALE PROSTITUTION PREVENTION PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS, Clark County, Nevada (the "County"), has entered into a grant agreement with the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) for participation in the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant ("JAG") program under the Consolidated Appropriations Act 2007, Public Law 108-447; and**

**WHEREAS, the County is responsible for the administration, implementation, planning and evaluation within its respective jurisdiction of the JAG Program and its respective BJA Plan (the "Plan"); and**

**WHEREAS, BJA does not have a matching fund requirement for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program; and**

**WHEREAS, the objectives of the activities which are funded by the JAG Program must be to reduce crime and improve public safety; and**

**WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas (the "Subrecipient") through its Municipal Court, will provide assistance to reduce crime and improve public safety through the Female Prostitution and Prevention Program (the "Program"); and**

**WHEREAS, the Subrecipient has requested financial assistance from the County to assist with this Program; and**

**WHEREAS, the County has agreed to provide Fiscal Year 2007 JAG funds (the "Funds") to the Subrecipient, such funding to be administered by the Community Resources Management Division ("CRMD"), a sub-entity of Clark County (CRMD and Subrecipient referenced collectively as "the parties"), for its Female Prostitution Prevention Program, as defined in Exhibit "A" "Expenditures Eligible for Reimbursement"; and**

**WHEREAS, the Subrecipient will provide assistance to women who have been engaged in alcohol, drugs and prostitution, to educate and counsel these women on risk of sexually transmitted diseases and HIV, and to subcontract with a non-profit organization to provide bed space for these women while going through rehabilitation, as an alternative of being incarcerated, in accordance with Exhibit "B", "Scope of Work", attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully set forth, and**

**WHEREAS, BJA specifically requires the parties to agree with respect to the following matters:**

- A. The manner in which services will be provided; and**

- B. The manner in which the parties will cooperate in administering and overseeing the financial aspects of the project or program; and**

**WHEREAS, NRS 277.180 permits one or more public agencies to contract with any one or more public agencies to perform any governmental service, activity or undertaking which any of the public agencies entering into the contract is authorized to perform by law.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the Act and related regulations and in consideration herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:**

- 1. CRMD shall provide a maximum of \$152,248 from Fiscal Year 2007/2008 JAG funds for the Female Prostitution Prevention Program by Subrecipient.**
- 2. Subrecipient agrees to use the Female Prostitution Prevention Program to address safety concerns throughout the community.**
- 3. Subrecipient will provide CRMD with documentation supporting any and all requests for payment of expenses against the Funds encumbered, and will provide any additional documentation requested by CRMD that may be required in the administration of the grant funds.**
- 4. Subrecipient shall comply with all Federal laws and regulations associated with the receipt of Justice Assistance Grant funds as a Subrecipient of such funds for the project identified in this Contract.**
- 5. It is specifically understood and agreed by Subrecipient that CRMD shall not be obligated to pay any monies to Subrecipient hereunder and hereafter in the event that such Federal funds for any reason are terminated or withheld from the County or are otherwise not forthcoming, and in such event, CRMD may terminate this Contract.**
- 6. This Contract shall take effect on the date of execution and shall continue in force and effect until terminated as delineated below:**
  - a. This Contract shall be completed by March 30, 2010. An extension of the March 30, 2010 deadlines must be authorized by the Manager of CRMD. The Manager of CRMD shall have the authority to reprogram these funds or any portion thereof to another project should the Subrecipient be unable to or unwillingly to complete this project by the March 30, 2010 deadline or its extension date approved by the Manager of CRMD; or**
  - b. By any party, for any reason with written notice of at least 60 days.**

**LAS VEGAS MUNICIPAL COURT  
FOR THE FEMALE PROSTITUTION AND PREVENTION PROGRAM**

**SCOPE OF WORK**

**Program Year 2007/2008**

- 1. Clark County will provide ONE HUNDRED FIFTY TWO THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED FORTY EIGHT AND NO/100TH DOLLARS (\$152,248) in Fiscal Year 2007/2008 Justice Assistance Grant funds (the "Funds"), to the City of Las Vegas ("Subrecipient") for its Municipal Court to provide assistance to women who have been engaged in alcohol, drugs and prostitution and provide a bed space for these women while going through rehabilitation as an alternative for being incarcerated.**
- 2. Subrecipient will provide notice to Clark County Community Resources Management Division of any program changes for which Fiscal Year 2007/2008 Justice Assistance Grant funds are allocated under the provisions of this Interlocal Agreement.**
- 3. Subrecipient will provide assistance to 55 female offenders who have been convicted of solicitation and who have been engaged in drug and alcohol abuse.**
- 4. Subrecipient will provide a listing of the number of females who have completed the program, and will need additional rehabilitation and counseling services.**
- 5. Subrecipient will contract with 2 residential facilities that will provide residential housing and bed space for first time female offenders, and rehabilitation services which will consist of educational classes on drugs, alcohol, sexually transmitted diseases, HIV risk, and treatment.**
