

RESOLUTION NO. R-78-2007

A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE
I-15 EXPRESS LANE PROJECT
I-15 FROM THE I-15/CC-215 INTERCHANGE TO SAHARA

WHEREAS, the Nevada Department of Transportation in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration are working in a cooperative partnership to develop and construct a project known as the "I-15 Corridor from north of I-215 (The Clark County Beltway) to south of Sahara Avenue Express Lanes" (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, a portion of the I-15 from north of I-215 (The Clark County Beltway) to south of Sahara Avenue lies within the boundaries of incorporated City of Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, Nevada Revised Statutes Section 408.397 provides that the Department of Transportation must obtain consent from the governing body of the city or town in which a highway is being changed or diverted; and

WHEREAS, the Project includes the following elements:

- Widening of I-15 from north of the I-15/I-215 Interchange to south of Sahara from 4 to 5 lanes in each direction.
- Widening includes designating the inside 2 lanes in each direction as Express Lanes.
- Express Lanes will be separated from the outside multi-purpose lanes by a 3' striped buffer zone with delineators.
- Trucks will be restricted from the inside Express Lane only. Trucks will be allowed in the outside Express Lane.
- Construction of the project is expected to begin in the spring of 2007 and be complete by the fall of 2009.

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation desires to obtain from the City Council its consent and support for the Project and its elements.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, at this regular meeting thereof being held on this ___th day of _____, 2007, as follows:

1. That the City Council consents to and supports the Project as described herein.
2. That the City Clerk be, and she hereby is, authorized, empowered and directed to furnish a copy of this Resolution to the Director of Public Works.

3. That all resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution be, and they hereby are, repealed.
