
#### JUSTIFICATION


The immediate surroundings of the Sunrise Vista Executive Suites include grocery store, gasoline station, single family houses, rental buildings and restaurants that will support the interests of families living in the area. The living units of the subject property have met the conditions for extended stay lodging. Each unit has a full bathroom (with tub and shower) and a kitchen which includes an oven/range combination, refrigerator as well as sink and cabinetry. Units are rented furnished with a full size bed, nightstand, dresser and dinette set. Units are provided with a through-the-wall air conditioners and hot water is provided by way of central gas boilers.

Office is open seven days a week to attend to the needs of the residents. If extended stay is available to valued customers, they're sure to benefit from unnecessary moving. Without the special use permit, the building is underutilized. It will be more profitable if we will be able to accept prospective tenants who want to rent weekly and monthly allowing them extended stay at their own discretion. This will also help us evaluate the customer satisfaction if tenants decide to extend their stay with us.
