Mr. Snelding reported that Deputy City Manager Orlando Sanchez has requested a performance comparison of Molasky Community School with other existing leisure facilities within the immediate area, with emphasis on programs and participation. He noted that in May 2004, a duplication of services analysis report was prepared by Leisure Services that covered many of the issues, and Molasky Community School was included.
