PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

A. T. & T. Communications of Nevada, Inc., has requested that the City of Las Vegas grant it a franchise agreement permitting its use of the City's rights-of-way for installing facilities to provide telecommunications services within the City. The proposed term of the franchise agreement is ten (10) years with an option to renew for five (5) years. A. T. & T. Communications of Nevada, Inc., will pay the City five percent (5%) of its annual gross revenue in accordance with the provisions of LVMC 6.67.020.
