NRS 408.397 provides that the Nevada Department of Transportation must obtain consent from the governing body of the city or town in which a highway is being changed as part of their environmental assessment. The proposed future project will widen US-95 from Washington Avenue to Kyle Canyon Road, improve interchanges at Cheyenne Avenue, Rancho Drive/Ann Road and Durango Drive and construct interchanges between US-95 and the Bruce Woodbury Beltway.
