CHAIRMAN GOYNES declared the Public Hearing open.

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This item was under the One Motion/One Vote portion of the agenda and was pulled at COMMISSIONER TRUESDELL'S request.

COMMISSIONER QUINN disclosed that her family's trust had purchased property from the applicant three years ago. DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY JAMES LEWIS stated she did not need to abstain on this item as she did not have an ongoing financial relationship with the applicant.

ANDY REED, Planning and Development Department, stated a field check of the sign was conducted on 12/17/07 found no visible graffiti or vandalism. As the pattern of development in the area has not changed, he recommended approval.

CHRIS KAMPPEN, 3800 Howard Hughes Parkway, appeared on behalf of the applicant. He noted the sign has been well-maintained and respectfully requested approval.

MARGO WHEELER, Director of the Planning and Development Department, informed COMMISSIONER TRUESDELL that approval for a digital board required a separate application and explained that approval of the required review would not change the sign itself.
