PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill will clarify the process for the nonrenewal of business licenses by requiring City Attorney approval to proceed, and requiring a notice of intent not to renew a license to be provided to the licensee at least 30 days before the licensing period expires.

Minutes:

CHIEF DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY STEED explained that this bill addresses the nonrenewal process and procedure for business licenses. He recommended approval with the inclusion of a First Amendment to Page 4 that would reduce the notice requirement from thirty to twenty-one days and add language regarding response by the City Attorney's office.

COUNCILMAN WOLFSON strongly urged the City Attorneys Office and the Director of Finance and Business Services to coordinate their efforts in support of the bill.
