This space will be used by recovering addicts and alcoholics for the purpose of sharing our experience, hopes and encouragement with each other (using 12 step formats such as A.A. and N.A.) to stay clean and sober. We have no counselors, therapists or professionals of any kind, and are staying clean and sober by the hundreds.

We have 5 meetings daily with 5 to 45 people which range from 1 hour to 2 hours. Anyone with a drug or alcohol problem is welcome to join us; we have no fees or dues, but those who can donate \$1 or \$2 per meeting to help pay the rent. There will be no loitering outside between meetings.

Suite #3 has been licensed for this purpose since 1999 as "Hope House". We have out grown it's 700 sq. ft. and would like to add 1100 sq.ft. suite #4 so more can join us for the life saving help we give each other.
