DEPUTY CITY MANAGER HOUCHEMS and NATHAN HODGSON, Vice President of Construction with Pulte Homes, joined the Mayor for this presentation.

MAYOR GOODMAN announced that sustainability has become one of the key initiatives for the City, which is committed to green building. As such, the City created its own Green Building Program, with the collaboration of the Southern Nevada Green Building Partnership, which was represented by CONNIE SUCKLER and MONICA CARUSSO. The Green Building Program encourages home builders and developers to build green homes and neighborhoods that are more energy efficient, environmentally friendly and sustainable for the City's quality of life.

The model homes of Pulte Homes' Timber Creek subdivision are the first participants in this program. On behalf of the entire Council, the Mayor thanked Pulte Homes and presented MR. HODGSON with a Proclamation declaring January 16, 2008, to be Pulte Homes-Timber Creek Day.

MR. HODGSON thanked the City for this honor, as well as the Southern Nevada Homebuilders Association and Energy Sense for helping Pulte Homes achieve this recognition. For Pulte Homes, it is an honor to be the green leader in the community.

DEPUTY CITY MANAGER HOUCHEMS said the City believes that sustainability programs will make the City a better place with more beautiful homes. He encouraged other developers interested in green building to contact the City.
