- Whereas;** the need for greater resource efficiencies has become imperative in order to sustain the quality of life we enjoy; and
- Whereas;** government in collaboration with the private sector can be a major force in informing the public about sustainable practice; and
- Whereas;** the City of Las Vegas adopted the Climate Protection Resolution calling for the City to establish programs to encourage builders and developers to implement "green" building practices to promote more energy-efficient, environmentally friendly and sustainable building practices; and
- Whereas;** the City of Las Vegas adopted the Green Building Resolution that all homes built in the city and certified as meeting the requirements of the Southern Nevada Green Building Partnership will be recognized and these homes will exceed the City's energy and water use conservation requirements and include a quantifiable volume of renewable and recycled content materials in construction; and
- Whereas;** Pulte Homes is the first homebuilder in the City of Las Vegas to certify the Timber Creek subdivision in the City's Green Building Program; now
