**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

This project provides for new construction and/or upgrade of existing asphalt concrete pavement, aggregate base, emulsified asphalt treated base for six travel lanes; three northbound and three southbound. Roadway improvements will include curb, gutter, sidewalk, driveways, storm drainage, landscaped median islands, and upgrade of existing traffic signals. The project starts on Martin Luther King Boulevard at the south property line of Costco Wholesale Corporation and proceeds north to Carey Avenue. Funding is provided by Regional Transportation Commission and Clark County Sewer Sanitation Funds.
