**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

This agenda item for the Sheep Mountain Parkway project is related to Item 37 approved at the City Council meeting of November 21, 2007. The previous action covered the Sheep Mountain Parkway between Iron Mountain Road and Hualapai Way. Whereas, the new agenda item overlaps the previous request and now includes the Parkway Corridor area south of Iron Mountain Road to the Western Beltway. The funding amount of \$13,500,000 on this action, and the \$6,000,000 previously approved, is a total of \$19,500,000 in funds that will be paid by the RTC.
