PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This project consists of the construction of a multi-use trail with pedestrian bridge along the Cedar Drainage Channel. Work will consist of the installation of a pre-fabricated steel pedestrian bridge, trail excavation, type II aggregate base, plantmix bituminous surface, installation of fencing, installation of traffic signage on Lamb Boulevard and other related work. Funding is provided by the Southern Nevada Public Land Management Act (SNPLMA).
