PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On July 23, 2007 Purchase Order No. 248409 in the amount of \$351,250 was awarded through the competitive bid process for soil transportation and stockpile management services in support of City Parkway V development activities located in Union Park. This revision to the purchase order increases the amount by \$400,000 for additional services as development activities have increased. Funding is provided by general obligation variable rate bonds.
