PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

These monies will allow the Senior Citizens Law Project (SCLP) to continue to provide legal services to senior citizens 60 years of age and older throughout Clark County. This \$60,000 grant has been awarded to the SCLP since 2004 to supplement its general operating expenses, which include but are not limited to: training expenses, office equipment, office supplies, interpreter services for non-English speaking clients as well as hearing impaired clients, and other related expenses. By supplementing the SCLP's operating expenses, the SCLP will continue to provide legal services to residents of Clark County aged 60 and older with particular emphasis placed on the individual's autonomy and free exercise of individual initiative in planning and managing their own lives. Particular attention is devoted to persons who are in the greatest social and economic need.
