PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Project Homeless Connect (formerly known as the Stand Down for the Homeless) is held at Cashman Center every November and is a one-stop shop event for homeless individuals and families. In 2008, the event will be held twice a year, once in the Spring and in the Fall. Dozens of area service providers provide a plethora of services ranging from medical to housing in order to assist individuals in becoming housed and self sufficient. This year, the event will be held Thursday, April 10, 2008 & Wednesday, October 8, 2008. As a partner, the city of Las Vegas supports the annual event by securing Cashman Center and covering the insurance indemnification. The Nevada Homeless Alliance is responsible for paying the usage fee.
