PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

A & H Jewelry, Inc. holds Jewelry Store License No. J01-01554-6-085997. Ahab Hamideh is the president of A & H Jewelry, Inc. He pled guilty in the Eighth Judicial District Court for the State of Nevada to one count of Possession of Counterfeiting Instrument, a Class C felony, in violation of NRS 205.180 August 2, 2007. He was found guilty and sentenced. On February 6, 2006, detectives executed a search warrant at A & H Jewelry, Inc. Officers seized hundreds of counterfeit watches. They also seized numerous items of jewelry which bore the imprint "14k." Presumptive tests revealed these items were not gold. Jewelry punches with the symbol "14k" on their tips were also seized. The president of A & H Jewelry, Inc. has been convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude, which relates to his business. He has operated the business as a nuisance.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council issue the Complaint for Disciplinary Action and set a date and time certain for hearing no later than 60 days from the date of approval of the complaint.
