
Dear Mr. Reed:

Calvary Community, as are most other churches, was founded in a spirit of giving to the hurting and needy of our community without regard to race, religion or ethnicity. One of our parishioners, Andrew Stutz DDS, has proposed creating a dental operator on the church premises primarily to treat the homeless and indigent. The facility would consist of two small rooms, one for patient treatment, the other for a compressor and vacuum to run the dental unit. We would be open on Saturdays and project treating 15-20 patients per week.

We will, of course, conform to all codes related to medical/dental offices. Recently, the Nevada Board of Dentistry passed a law allowing dentists to receive 6 continuing education credits toward their annual requirement of 20 for treating indigent patients in this type of setting. Therefore, our clinic would serve a dual purpose. Most treatments rendered would be of an emergency nature to relieve pain and suffering. Dr. Stutz would be the primary caregiver.

Our main obstacle in seeing this vision come to fruition is zoning. Please consider allowing us to move forward on this much-needed dental treatment operator by granting the proper zoning.
