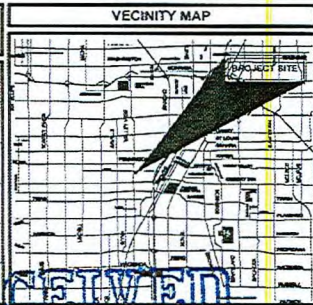

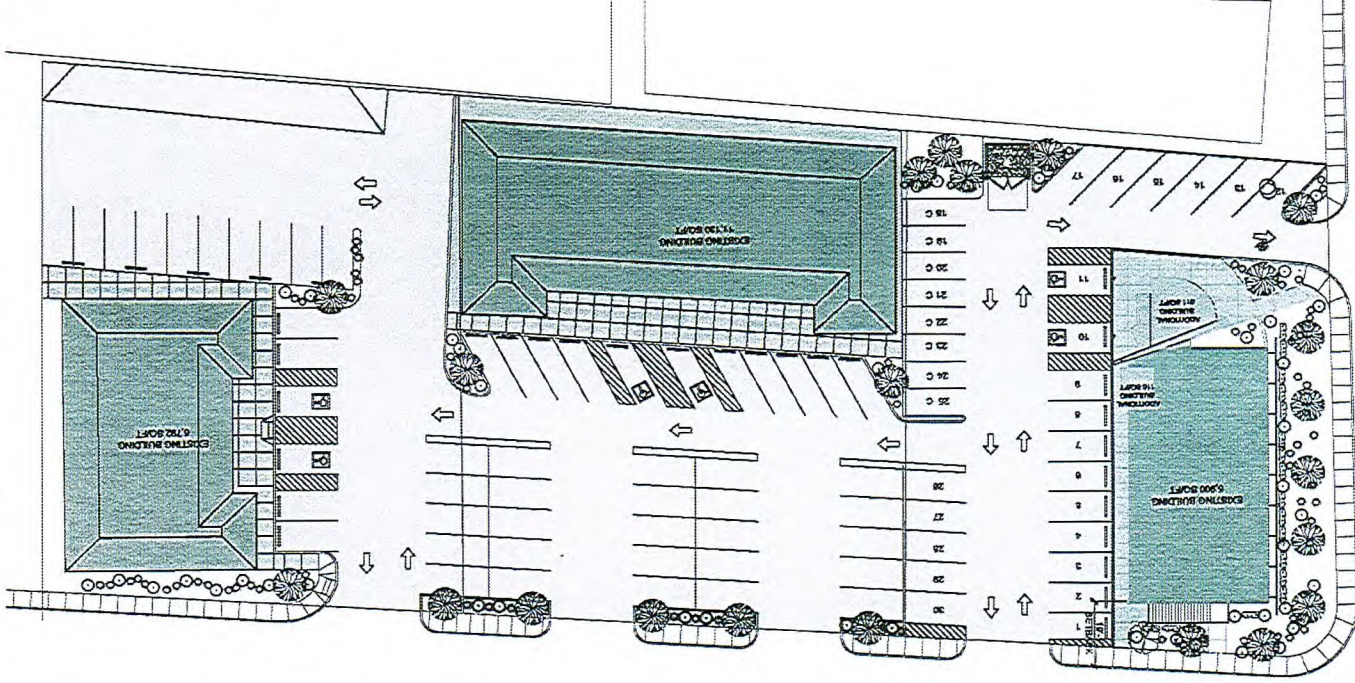

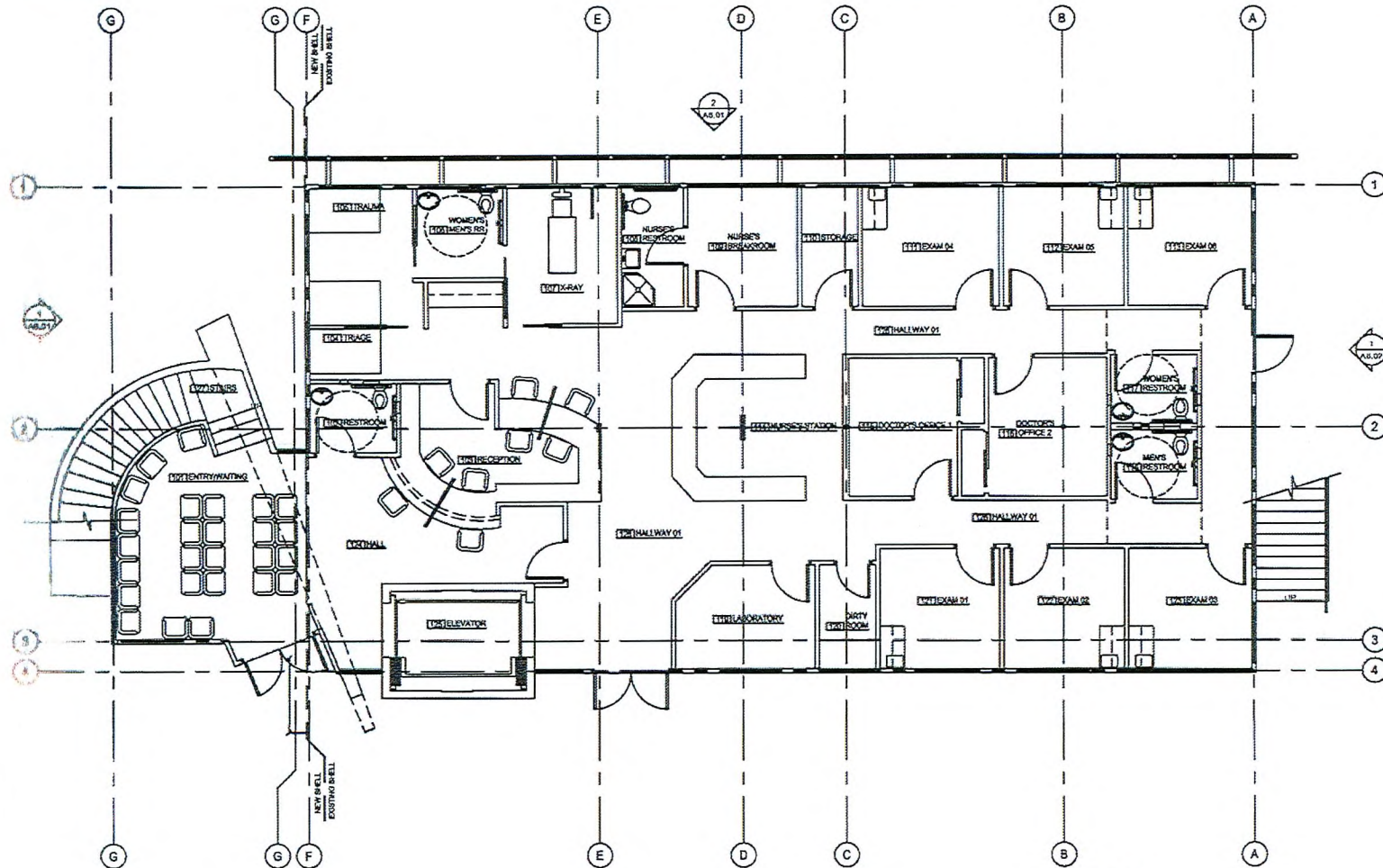
1. LANDSCAPE PLANS SHALL INCLUDE A MINIMUM OF 4" RISE CURBS.

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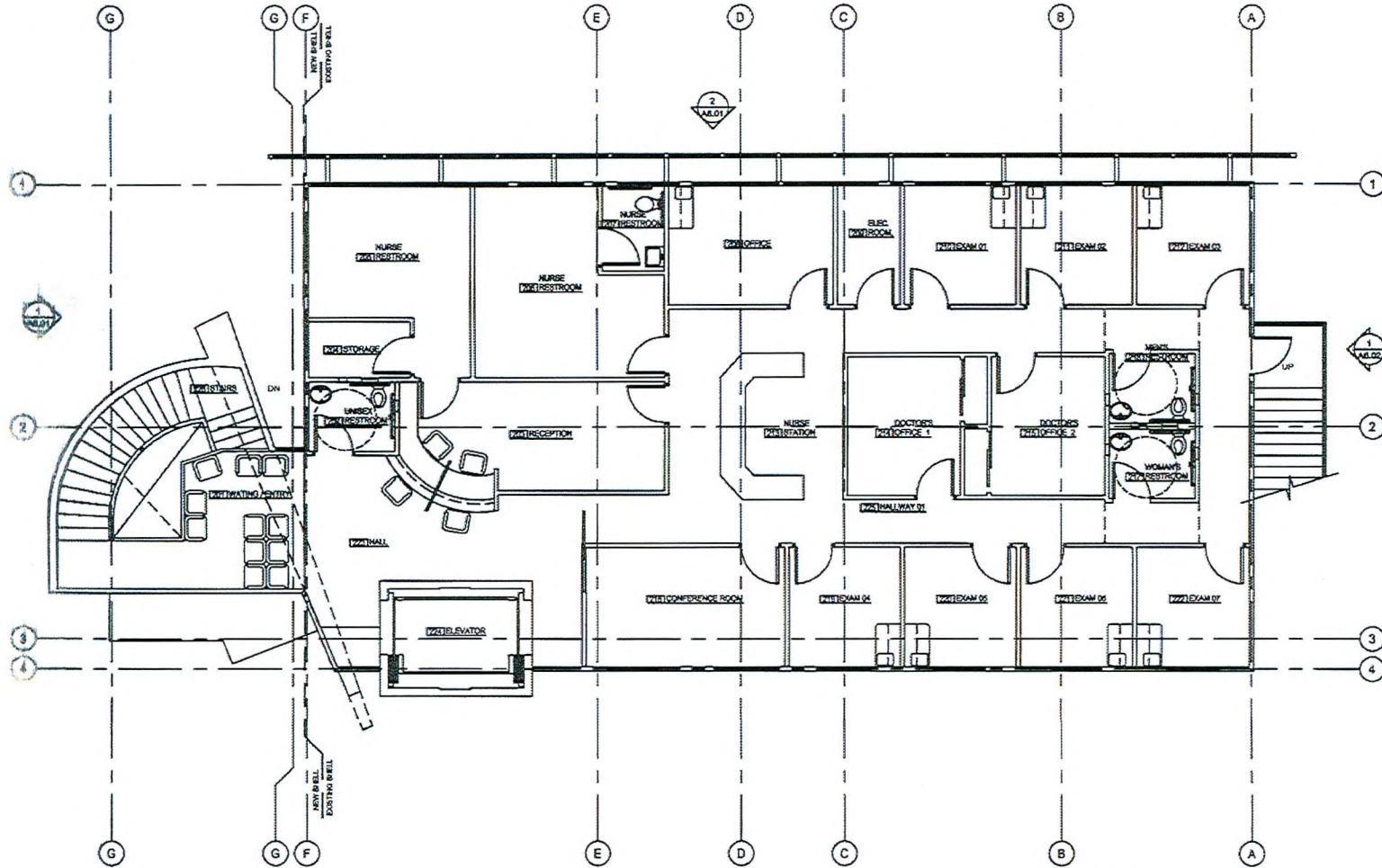

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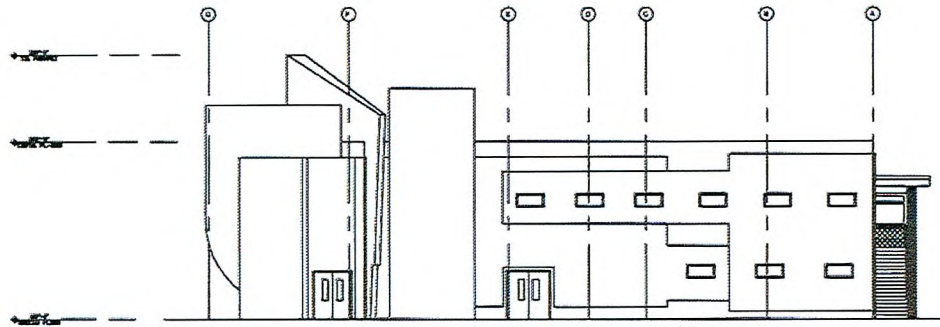

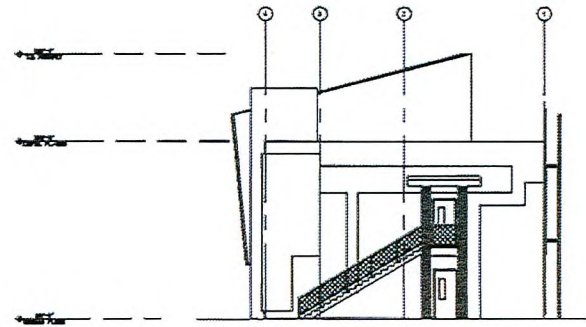

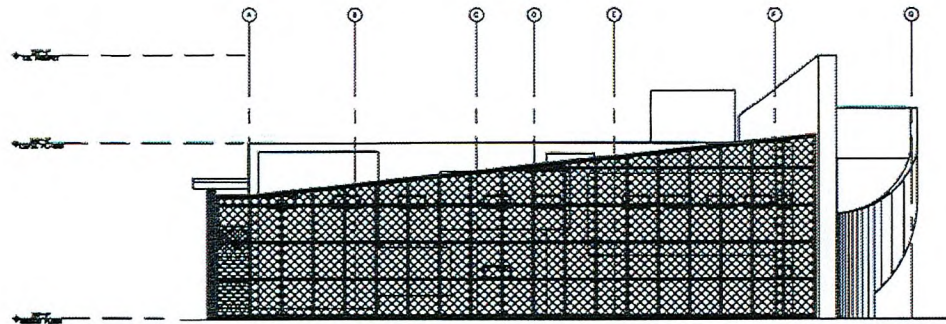
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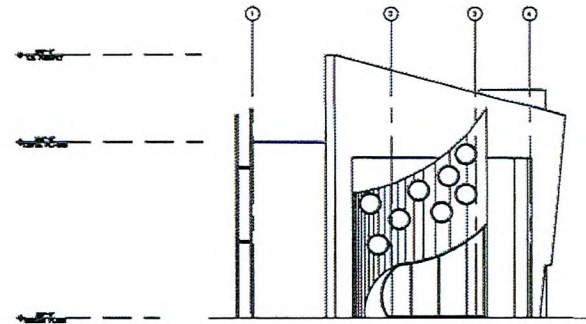
1 EXTERIOR EAST ELEVATION

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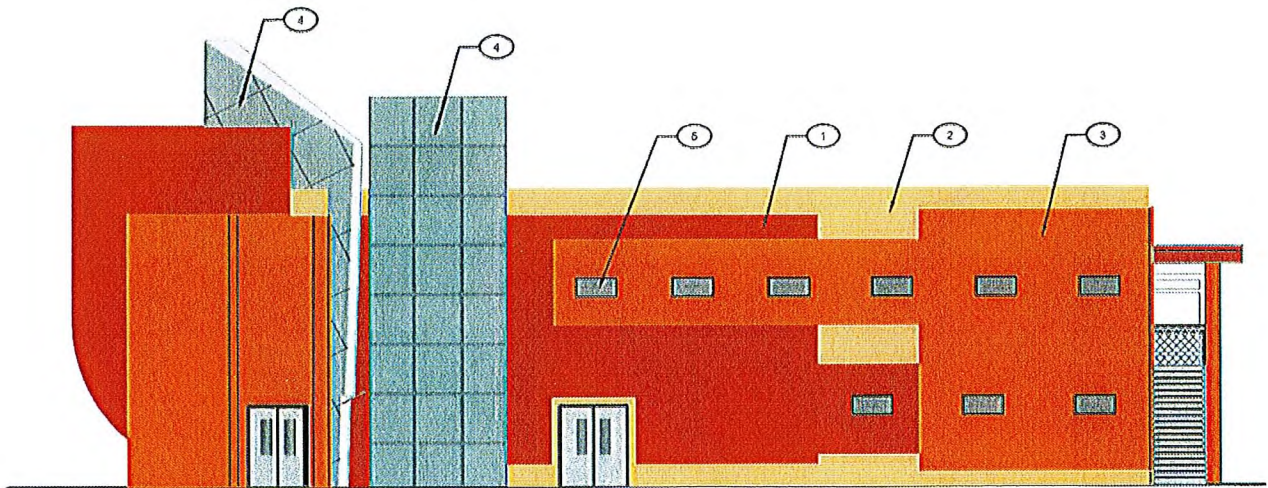
