# Proclamation


- Whereas;** Presented by the Southern Nevada Off-Road Enthusiasts, the Mint 400 is returning to Las Vegas for the first time after a historical period from 1968-1988 when it drew more than 100,000 fans; and
- Whereas;** this championship of America's fastest off-road racing cars is being held March 27-30, 2008 in Las Vegas/Primm and is sponsored by General Tire, El Cortez Hotel and Casino, Fremont East Entertainment District, and Terrible's Primm Valley Casino Resorts; and
