PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Citizens in these areas have expressed concerns over the need for lighting in their neighborhoods in order to improve safety. There are currently no lights on the sections of 11th Street and Ronald Lane. Since the neighborhoods are located in a CDBG targeted area, the installation of new street lights meets a HUD National Objective.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the funding for the 11th Street and Ronald Lane Light Installation Projects and authorize the Department Directors to execute any and all related agreements and documents required for the projects, following approval as to form by the City Attorney.
