Minutes:

The appellant was present, accompanied by his attorney, JAY BROWN.

TONI WEEKS, Detective, Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (Metro), referenced the confidential report and explained that MR. LOMONACO is on probation for one charge. The employer did not send a letter, but the employer was in the audience in support.

ATTORNEY BROWN stated that MR. LOMONACO has resided in Las Vegas since 1967 and has worked in the club business for 20 years. He was working at the Crazy Horse in 2001 when he was convicted for failure to pay taxes, for which he was very remorseful and immediately took responsibility. MR. LOMONACOS only experience has been in the gaming industry, is 65 years old, has been married for 35 years and helps support his 75-year-old sister.
