PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

From time to time the Clark County Regional Flood Control District revises its Uniform Regulations for the Control of Drainage. Local governments within Clark County are required to adopt those regulations, and amendments thereto, in order to qualify for related State and Federal funding and in order to comply with requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency. This bill will bring the City into compliance.

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN declared the Public Hearing open.

CHIEF DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY VAL STEED stated that this bill is in response to a request from the Federal Emergency Management Agency and Clark County Flood Control District to update regulations to reflect changes in flood maps, definitions and new kinds of uses. This is the latest manual that everyone adopts. Staff recommends approval, adopting the

uniform regulations verbatim in order to make people in the City eligible for federal and state funds when flooding occurs.
