Minutes:

TODD FARLOW expressed concern with height limitations and energy costs. He encouraged the Commissioners to read a sustainable design article.

FLINN FAGG, Planning and Development Department, discussed future elements to be included in the 2020 Master Plan in order to bring the City of Las Vegas into compliance with the Nevada Revised Statutes. Two of the elements which will be presented to the Commission for consideration in May.

The first element would be the Community Design element which is intended to address standards governing the subdivision of land with suggestive patterns for community development.

The second element would be the School Facilities element which will show the current and future schools in the City. It also speaks of partnering with the School District and looking at future facility designs.

MR. FAGG spoke of the upcoming American Planning Association Conference, to be held at the end of the month and remarked that there are approximately 6,100 persons registered. He thanked the Commissioners who will participate as guides or hosts.
