No motion required. A presentation was made.

COUNCILMAN BROWN introduced JENNIFER SZWEJBKA, District Coordinator of the Conservation District of Southern Nevada, and stated that a critical component of water conservation is stormwater quality, by protecting the water going to Lake Mead and avoiding contamination of the water supply. He noted that a kickoff event would be held 4/4/2008 to raise awareness about stormwater quality.

MS. SZWEJBKA announced that awareness would be raised by placing plaques, of which she showed a sample, above storm drains across the Valley to remind residents not to pollute because the water flows directly into Lake Mead. She thanked the Council for proclaiming April as Stormwater Quality Awareness Month and accepted the proclamation.
