The applicant was present.

JIM DiFIORE, Manager of Business Services, said the original conditions imposed on Item 48 were also imposed on this item. There were 20 calls for service not generated by the police department. During an inspection, a warning was issued for not having security on the premises after 2:00 p.m. as required. MR. JARJEES was charged with battery and has been required to stay out of trouble for nine months, attend counseling and appear for a review in September 2008. Any additional conditions or further reviews on this permanent license would have to be approved by the Council.

CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF: APRIL 2, 2008

MR. JARJEES explained that security was not available on the day of the inspection, because the guard did not show up for work as expected. COUNCILMAN BARLOW advised MR. JARJEES that he would not tolerate the activity that has been taking place outside of his business. He asked MR. JARJEES to assist him and run an efficient business, requiring that he add another security guard, as well imposing another six-month review. He also encouraged MR. JARJEES to work closely with the Bolden Area Command.
