ANTHONY HODGES, 127 Sir David, commented on the current Presidential bids. He felt that Congress should be the one to run this nation, and individuals that have been in Congress for over 30 years need to be removed from office as they have been there too long.

DOROTHY BARNES reiterated comments about individuals from Nellis Air Force Base and within religious organizations utilizing her name on programs without her permission.

RASHAN JOSHUA COLLINS, advocate for Christian values and the homeless, confirmed with COUNCILMAN REESE and MAYOR GOODMAN that a particular Consent item was approved. He encouraged the Council and everyone to support him in protesting the upcoming gay/lesbian parade and not promote sin. He referenced the Bible and the Nevada Revised Statutes and urged those to take heed to his warnings.

ROGER HARRIS, 4730 Craig Road, stated he is a part of a national campaign for clean energy. He is the lead organizer for the efforts within Nevada, which is sponsored by the Sierra Club. He thanked Council for their efforts, as it allows individuals like him to be involved. The campaign will run until Earth Day and asked everyone to be open to what they have to say. He encouraged all to keep promoting clean energy.
