COUNCILMAN BARLOW pronounced that recently he was approached by NANCY MENZEL from the UNLV School of Nursing seeking his consent for her team of students to conduct an assessment of community issues regarding the homeless population in Ward 5. He met with the team to discuss some of the issues and to provide some insight on the problems in Ward 5. One month later, the team came back with the result of its research and with some intervention plans, which he summarized: job counseling, support of the regional plan to end homelessness, focus on assisting children and families, protect the homeless against crime and provide transitional housing for chronic alcohol abusers.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW introduced MS. MENZEL and thanked COUNCILMAN BARLOW and his colleagues for their support in the assessment. COUNCILMAN BARLOW then named the students who conducted the assessment and presented each of them with a Certificate of Appreciation as they came forward.
