Our Charleston Neighborhood Preservation board members noted the "one motion/one vote" approval of CLV agenda item #35 recommending an award of \$50,000.00 to the Parks and Leisure Activities Capital Projects Fund for Post Modern Post office, this AM with despair.

We expected professionals to present dynamic testimony for a NO vote on that item because the future for the 301 Stewart Ave antique United States Post Office has been spoken of as a 'Mob Museum'. We also expected that item #35 would be pulled from the CONSENT portion of the agenda.

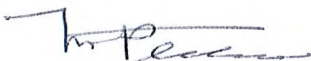
FREE local phone calling, FREE long distance calling, FREE fast broadband Internet access, and have mini-kitchen, shower, toilet and bedroom integrated.
