COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN introduced local teacher PHIL BOMBINO and presented him with a proclamation declaring May 21, 2008, as PHIL BOMBINO DAY. She stated that the Magnet Programs at Clark High School have for many years been recognized for producing outstanding national merit scholarship winners. MR. BOMBINO is one of fifty educators that was recently presented with the 2007-2008 Siemens Award, which recognizes exemplary teachers in the advanced placement program.

Accepting the Proclamation, MR. BOMBINO credited his students for their diligence in pursuing their educational goals. He noted that over the thirteen years he has taught calculus at Clark High School, there have been an enormous number of students who have gone on to such colleges as Yale, Princeton, UCLA, etc. In speaking of his students, he stated that their achievements are often overlooked.
