NOTE: COUNCILMAN WOLFSON disclosed that he recused himself on this matter in the past because of opposition to this application and out of fairness, as the owners of a business across the street from the subject business are good friends of his family and he and his family have done business with them for many years. He noted that he would abstain on Items 37 and 38.

Minutes:

MAYOR GOODMAN read Items 37 and 38 to be heard together.

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GUADALUPE M. LIMON was present.

CAROL MEYER, Supervisor of Business Services, stated the applicant met the requirements to be considered for a temporary license. She suggested approval as recommended.

Regarding Item 38, COUNCILMAN BARLOW questioned the pistol permit. MS. MEYER explained that the business could take in firearms but could not sell them from the location. They will be sold through someone with authority and only in the Reno area.

Moreover, after the motion was made on Item 38, COUNCILMAN BARLOW clarified with COUNCILMAN REESE that the pistol permit condition carries with the location and would also apply to future operators, should the license be sold.
