**ITEM DESCRIPTION: VAC-27447 - APPLICANT/OWNER: HOTSPUR RESORTS NEVADA, LTD**

### **\*\* CONDITIONS \*\***

The Planning Commission (5-0 vote) and staff recommend APPROVAL, subject to:

1. The limits of this Petition of Vacation shall be the ingress/egress right-of-way generally located on the west side of Rampart Boulevard, approximately 340 feet north of Canyon Run Drive.
2. A public sewer easement shall be retained overlying the existing public sewer.
3. No portion of existing public drainage easement per Doc: 940119:01045 shall be vacated.
4. All existing public improvements, if any, adjacent to and in conflict with this vacation application are to be modified, as necessary, at the applicant's expense prior to the recordation of the Order of Vacation.
5. Reservation of easements for the facilities of the various utility companies together with reasonable ingress thereto and egress there from shall be provided if required. Only for R.O.W. vacations.
6. All development shall be in conformance with code requirements and design standards of all City Departments.
7. The Order of Vacation shall not be recorded until all of the conditions of approval have been met provided, however, that conditions requiring modification of public improvements may be fulfilled for purposes of recordation by providing sufficient security for the performance thereof in accordance with the Subdivision Ordinance of the City of Las Vegas. City Staff is empowered to modify this application if necessary because of technical concerns or because of other related review actions as long as current City rightofway requirements are still complied with and the intent of the vacation application is not changed. If applicable, a five foot wide easement for public streetlight and fire hydrant purposes shall be retained on all vacation actions abutting public street corridors that will remain dedicated and available for public use. Also, if applicable and where needed, public easement corridors and sight visibility or other easements that would/should cross any right-of-way or easement being vacated must be retained.

8. If the Order of Vacation is not recorded within one (1) year after approval by the City of Las Vegas or an Extension of Time is not granted by the Planning Director, then approval will terminate and a new petition must be submitted.

**\*\* STAFF REPORT \*\***

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

This is a Petition to Vacate ingress/egress easements located at 221 North Rampart Boulevard. The Vacation of these easements is a required condition for a Parcel Map (PMP-6436). Approval of this Vacation will allow for the requested Parcel Map to continue through the review process; therefore as these ingress/egress easements are no longer needed, staff recommends approval of this request.

**DESCRIPTION**

**ANALYSIS**

**A) Planning discussion**

The proposed Vacation of ingress/egress easements is a required condition of Parcel Map (PMP-6436). Approval of this request will allow the recording of a three-lot Parcel Map. These ingress/egress easements are no longer needed in their current configuration; therefore staff recommends approval of this request.

**B) Public Works discussion**

Public Works notes that this Vacation application was required by Parcel Map PMP-6436, Condition Number Three. The City of Las Vegas no longer accepts public ingress/egress easements and/or right-of-way for the purpose of handicap accessibility.
