Approval of Second Supplemental to the Interlocal Contract LLD12A04 between the City of Las Vegas and the Clark County Regional Flood Control District (CCRFCD) to increase construction funding and extend the date of completion for local drainage improvements for the Brush Street storm drain (\$241,002 - CCRFCD) Ward 1 (Tarkanian)

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

On June 10, 2004, the Regional Flood Control District entered into an Interlocal Contract with the City of Las Vegas for the construction of local drainage improvements for the Brush Street storm drain. The First Supplemental Interlocal Contract to extend the date of completion was approved on July 13, 2006. This Second Supplemental Interlocal Contract is to increase construction funding to the amount of \$428,502, reflecting the current engineers cost estimate. This project is entirely within one fourth mile of an existing Regional Flood Control District facility and is eligible for 100 percent construction funding. This second supplemental also extends the project completion date to October 27, 2009. The extension of time is needed in order to include the Brush Street improvements with the Alta Parallel System project. This completion date matches the proposed completion date for the Alta Parallel System project. The total cost of the contract shall not exceed \$428,502.
