Minutes:

DOROTHY BAKER expressed difficulty in opening a checking account and is seeking assistance from a pre-paid legal source. She does not promote sin as a way of life and is still disappointed at others using her name illegally.

DANIEL FRANK ZAPIAN was happy to have established a 501(c)(3) corporation, Rosy Land, which is dedicated to providing shelter for homeless youth. He urged the Council's assistance and asked that the City donate land to him. MAYOR GOODMAN suggested MR. ZAPIAN meet with one of the City's representatives to discuss his request further.

GRACE HALL has lived in Las Vegas, Nevada for five weeks. She has experienced confusion and difficulty in getting the proper identification, obtaining a work card and making ends meet here in Nevada. MAYOR GOODMAN explained that action could not be taken but directed her to speak with ACTING CITY MANAGER ORLANDO SANCHEZ regarding possible assistance through Catholic Charities and obtaining the proper identification.

TOM McGOWAN, Las Vegas resident, was pleased how the Council handled a previous item. He asked Council to direct staff to arrange a meeting to discuss what the next course of action would be. At his request, DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY JAMES LEWIS explained the Council has the discretion to end the discussion on an item or continue hearing the item. MAYOR GOODMAN added that, specifically, the Councilperson making the motion can end the discussion as well.

CHLOE JORDAN, COUNCILMAN BARLOW'S intern, thanked him for the opportunity to sit in the meeting and view politics in a different light and to see how the City Council meetings are conducted.
