

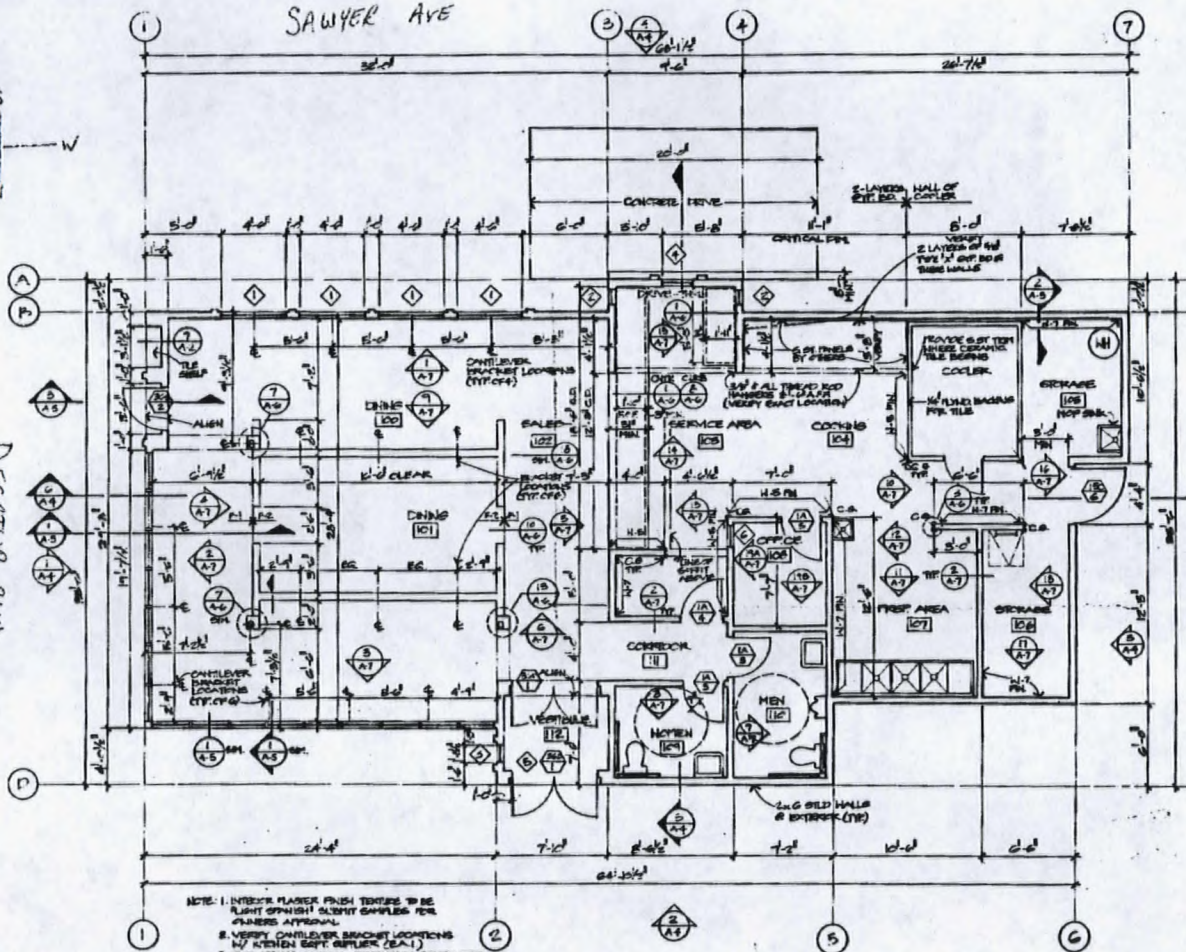

GENERAL NOTES

1. BY EXECUTING THE CONTRACT THE CONTRACTOR REPRESENTS THAT HE HAS READ THE SPECIFICATIONS, DRAWINGS AND ALL THE CONDITIONS AND AGREES TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.
2. THE S.D.T. OF THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS IS TO SECURE ALL ITEMS NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER EXECUTION OF THE WORK. THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS ARE COMPLEMENTARY & WHAT IS REQUIRED BY ANY ONE SHALL BE AS REQUIRED BY ALL. UNLESS IT IS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROPER SELECTION AND IS RESPONSIBLY INFERABLE THEREFROM AS BEING NECESSARY TO PROVIDE THE INTENDED RESULTS. NOTES & ALL SPECIFICATIONS WHICH ARE WILLIAMSON, TECHNICAL, OR TRADE, TERMINAL ARE USED IN THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUCH RECOMMENDED MEASUREMENTS.
3. THE DRAWINGS & SPECIFICATIONS ARE INTENDED TO BE FULL EXPLANATORY AND SUFFICIENT THAT INDIVIDUAL ITEMS BE SPECIFIED, DESIGN OR SPECIFIED ON A.S. & NOT THE OTHER, IT SHALL BE DONE.
4. BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE WORK, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FURNISH TO THE ARCHITECT, IN WRITING, A LIST OF ALL MATERIALS, EQUIPMENT, AND THE GENERAL CONDITIONS CONTRACT EACH OTHER IN ANY POINT OR SPECIFIC CLARIFICATION, THE CONTRACTOR MUST BE TO THE ATTENTION OF THE ARCHITECT AND NO MODIFICATION SHALL BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO THE APPROVAL OF THE ARCHITECT. THE ARCHITECT'S INTERPRETATION SHALL GOVERN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE WORK. NO ALTERATION SHALL BE MADE IN THE CONTRACTOR'S DESIGN OR SPECIFICATIONS ON HIS PART IN THIS CONNECTION.
5. PROTECTIVE CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS SHALL SECURE ALL DATA AT THE SITE OF THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION, EACH AS DESIGNER OF LIST, DIMENSIONS OF EXISTING AND EXISTING MATERIALS, LOCATION OF PUBLIC SERVICES, AND OTHER INFORMATION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL HAVE A REMARK ON HANDING THESE RECORDS OR IN THE EXECUTION OF THE WORK. IF ANY OF THE CONTRACTOR, AND NO REFERENCE SHALL BE MADE TO THE FAILURE OF THE CONTRACTOR TO OBTAIN SUCH ON-SITE INFORMATION PRIOR TO BIDDING.
6. SHOULD ANY ERROR OR INCONSISTENCY APPEAR IN THE DRAWINGS OR SPECIFICATIONS, THE CONTRACTOR, BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH THE WORK, MUST CLARIFY, RE-STATE THE SAME TO THE ATTENTION OF THE ARCHITECT FOR PROPER ADJUSTMENT, AND IN NO CASE PROCEED WITH THE WORK IN DISOBEYANCE NOR WITH MODIFICATION OF THE DRAWINGS.
7. THE CONTRACTOR AND EACH SUBCONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR VERIFICATION OF ALL MEASUREMENTS AT AND IN THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION RECORDS OR SITE OR RECORDS. NO CHARGE OF CORRECTION SHALL BE ALLOWED DUE TO THE CONTRACTOR'S FAILURE TO OBTAIN ACTUAL MEASUREMENTS & DIMENSIONS LOCATED ON THE DRAWINGS. ANY SUCH INADEQUACY IN CONSTRUCTION WHICH MAY BE FOUND, SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE ARCHITECT FOR HIS COMMENT BEFORE THE CONTRACTOR PROCEEDS WITH THE WORK IN THE AFFECTED AREA.
8. CONTRACTORS SHALL RELY ON THE SPECIFICATIONS OR RELIED ON DRAWINGS IN REFERENCE TO SCALE, DIMENSIONS, AND RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THEM IN REFERENCE TO EXISTING DRAWINGS, AND RELY ON ACTUAL FIELD CONDITIONS.
9. UNLESS IT IS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROPER SELECTION AND IS RESPONSIBLY INFERABLE THEREFROM AS BEING NECESSARY TO PROVIDE THE INTENDED RESULTS. NOTES & ALL SPECIFICATIONS WHICH ARE WILLIAMSON, TECHNICAL, OR TRADE, TERMINAL ARE USED IN THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUCH RECOMMENDED MEASUREMENTS.
10. PROTECTION SHALL BE PROVIDED BY OWNER.
