## Time Line of Events

July 19, 2007 Applied for license to sell wheels and tires. (see Exhibit "1")

August 1, 2007 License No. A39-00427-1-136478 issues. Category A-39

April 22, 2008 Kelly Oliverius (Code Enforcement Officer) warns Economy Wheel & Accessory that it is operating under the wrong type of business license. She further tells Economy that they need a special use permit.

April 22, 2008 Economy seeks out advice at City Business License and is informed that the A-39 license is the correct license.

May 2, 2008 Economy is issued a Notice of Violation. LVMC 6.02.320(A), LVMC 19.04.010/9.04.020, LVMC 19.04.040(B)/9.04.020. (see Exhibit "2")

May 2, 2008 Code Enforcement Officer Kelly Oliverius issues Economy a cease and desist effectively closing the business of Economy.

May 2, 2008 Economy re-applies for a new business license in an attempt to comply with Oliverius' demands. (see Exhibit "3")

May 2, 2008 Planning approves a new A-39 Business License. (see Exhibit "4")

May 5, 2008 Fire approves a new A-39 Business License. (see Exhibit "4")

May 6, 2008 Director approves a new A-39 Business License (see Exhibit "4")

May 8, 2008 New A-39 license issues (License No. A39-00448-1-136410)

July 2, 2008 No record of new or old license. Economy has an "out of business" status.

If the applicant is not the property owner, the property owner must sign the application where indicated or otherwise give written permission for this use of the property. The Planning Director must be satisfied that the proposed home occupation will comply with the following standards.

1. Only the occupants of the dwelling unit shall be engaged in the business activity approved for the Home Occupation Permit.
2. No employees shall report to work or be dispatched from the property.
3. There shall be no transacting of business or offers to transact business with customers or clients who have come to the property.
4. There shall be no signage or other advertising of any kind, whether on the property or elsewhere, which advertises the address or physical location of the property or identifies the existence of a Home Occupation on the property. A home telephone number or a post office box may be advertised by any medium other than on-site language.
5. No motor vehicle repair, paint or body work, commercial preparation of food for service on the premises, business related to or involving explosives, ammunitions or weapons, beauty parlor or barber shop, or ambulance or related emergency services shall be permitted as Home Occupation.
6. A Home Occupation shall not create pedestrian, automobile or truck traffic in excess of the normal amount associated with residential uses in the district.
7. A Home Occupation business shall be conducted exclusively within the main dwelling or within an accessory structure which has been approved for the Home Occupation Permit, except for horticultural activities.
8. The number of on-site parking spaces shall not be reduced to less than two.

9. No Home Occupation business shall create or cause noise, dust, light, vibration, gas, fumes, toxic or hazardous materials, smoke, glare, electrical interference or other hazards or nuisances either on or off the premises.
10. There shall be no electrical or mechanical equipment which is not normally found in a residential structure and no equipment found on the premises shall cause a change in the fire safety or occupancy classification of the dwelling unit.
11. There shall be no outdoor storage or use of any toxic chemicals or hazardous materials of any type or in any amount not normally found in a residential structure.
12. No more than one vehicle with a maximum capacity of one ton shall be used in connection with a Home Occupation Permit.

## 6.02.090 Action on application—Refusal grounds.

(A) Other than an application for a license which requires prior approval by an agency of the State, an application for a license which requires formal approval of the Council to which the exemptions in LVMC 6.02.070(E)(1)-(4) do not apply, or a license that is subject to the provisions of LVMC Chapter 6.06, the Director, not more than thirty calendar days after receipt of an application for a license, shall approve, deny or take such other action with respect to such application as the Director considers appropriate. In the event that any department that the Director consults regarding an application is unable to complete its review thereof in time for the Director to comply with such thirty-calendar-day requirement, the Director shall issue a temporary license as provided in LVMC 6.02.070. The Director may:

(1) Deny an applicant a license if:

- (a) The application is incomplete or contains false, misleading or fraudulent statements with respect to any information that is required in the application;
- (b) The applicant, prospective licensee or any of its principals fails to satisfy any qualification or requirement that is imposed by this Code, or other local, State or Federal law or regulation that pertains to the particular license or approval for suitability which is sought;
- (c) The applicant, prospective licensee or any of its principals resides in the United States illegally;
- (d) The applicant, prospective licensee or any of its principals is engaged, or has commenced, instituted, advertised, aided, carried on, continued or engaged, in a business, trade or profession without having obtained a valid license, an approval for suitability, a permit or a work card when such a person knew that one was required or under such circumstances that they reasonably should have known one was required, or has solicited, encouraged, caused or procured another to do so;
- (e) The applicant, prospective licensee or any of its principals has been subject, in any jurisdiction, to disciplinary action of any kind with respect to a license, an approval for suitability, a permit or a work card to the extent that such disciplinary action reflects upon the qualification, acceptability or fitness of the applicant, prospective licensee or any of its principals;
- (f) The applicant, prospective licensee or any of its principals has been convicted of an act that constitutes a crime which involves moral turpitude or involves any local, State or Federal law or regulation which relates to the same or a similar business, or has been convicted of having solicited, encouraged, caused or procured another to commit such a violation;
- (g) The applicant, prospective licensee or any of its principals has been convicted of having perpetrated, or solicited, encouraged, caused or procured another to perpetrate, deceptive practices upon the public;
- (h) The applicant, prospective licensee or any of its principals suffers from a legal disability under the laws of the State;
- (i) The premises on which the business is proposed to be conducted do not satisfy local, state or federal laws or regulations which pertain to the activity that is proposed to be engaged in; or
- (j) The proposed business activity constitutes, promotes, fosters, aids or otherwise enables a private nuisance, public nuisance or chronic nuisance.

(2) Refuse to renew a license if:

- (a) The licensee or any of its principals is engaged, or has commenced, instituted, advertised, aided, carried on, continued or engaged, in a business, trade or profession without having obtained a valid license, an approval for suitability, a permit or a work card when such a person knew that one was required or under such circumstances that they reasonably should have known one was required, or has solicited, encouraged, caused or procured another to do so;
- (b) The licensee, any of its principals, or their employees or those acting on their behalf,

have been subject, in any jurisdiction, to disciplinary action of any kind with respect to a license, an approval for suitability, a permit or a work card to the extent that such disciplinary action reflects upon the qualification, acceptability or fitness of such licensee or any principal;

(c) The licensee, any of its principals, or their employees or those acting on their behalf, have been convicted of an act that constitutes a crime which involves moral turpitude or involves any local, State or Federal law or regulation which relates to the same or a similar business, or have been convicted of having solicited, encouraged, caused or procured another to commit such a violation;

(d) The licensee, any of its principals, or their employees or those acting on their behalf, violate a condition which is imposed upon the license;

(e) The licensee, any of its principals, or their employees or those acting on their behalf, have been convicted of having perpetrated deceptive practices upon the public;

(f) The licensee or any of its principals suffers from a legal disability under the laws of the State;

(g) The premises on which the business is conducted do not satisfy local, state or federal laws or regulations which pertain to the activity which is actually engaged in; or

(h) The business activity constitutes, promotes, causes, allows, fosters, aids, or otherwise enables a private nuisance, public nuisance or chronic nuisance, or has been or is being conducted in an unlawful, illegal or impermissible manner, including but not limited to causing, allowing, promoting, fostering, aiding, enabling, exercising deliberate ignorance towards or failing to abate a private nuisance, public nuisance or chronic nuisance.

(B) The Director shall base a decision to deny, revoke, suspend or fail to renew any license sought or obtained under this Chapter upon the objective criteria set forth in Subsection (A) and not upon a desire or need to suppress or censor expressive material, or to address conduct that does not constitute or aid and abet criminal conduct or activity or other conduct harmful to the public health, safety, welfare, morals and peace.

#### **6.02.100 Issuance—Content.**

Upon final approval of a license application and upon payment of all required fees and taxes, the Director shall issue a license. The license shall specify the classification of the license, the premises where the business is allowed and the name of the licensee.

The City Council shall hear the applicant at the next regularly scheduled meeting following the expiration of ten days after the applicant filed a notice of appeal. **EXHIBIT "7"**

### **6.02.330 Disciplinary action—Good cause designated.**

A licensee may be subject to disciplinary action by the City Council for good cause, which may, without limitation, include the following:

- (A) The licensee or any of its principals is engaged, or has commenced, instituted, advertised, aided, carried on, continued or engaged, in a business, trade or profession without having obtained a valid license, an approval for suitability, a permit or a work card when such a person knew that one was required or under such circumstances that they reasonably should have known one was required, or has solicited, encouraged, caused or procured another to do so;
  - (B) The licensee or any of its principals has been subject, in any jurisdiction, to disciplinary action of any kind with respect to a license, an approval for suitability, a permit or a work card to the extent that such disciplinary action reflects upon the qualification, acceptability or fitness of such licensee or principal;
  - (C) The licensee or any of its principals has been convicted of an act which constitutes a crime which involves moral turpitude or involves any local, state or federal law or regulation which relates to the same or a similar business, or has been convicted of having solicited, encouraged, caused or procured another to commit such a violation;
  - (D) The licensee or any of its principals, or their employees or those acting on their behalf, violate a condition which is imposed upon the license;
  - (E) The licensee or any of its principals has been convicted of having perpetrated, or has solicited, encouraged, caused or procured another to perpetrate, deceptive practices upon the public;
  - (F) The licensee or any of its principals suffers from a legal disability under the laws of the State;
  - (G) The premises on which the business is conducted do not satisfy local, state or federal law or regulations which pertain to the activity which is actually engaged in;
  - (H) The business activity constitutes, promotes, causes, allows, fosters, aids, or otherwise enables a private nuisance, public nuisance or chronic nuisance, or has been or is being conducted in an unlawful, illegal or impermissible manner, including but not limited to causing, allowing, promoting, fostering, aiding, enabling, exercising deliberate ignorance towards or failing to abate a private nuisance, public nuisance or chronic nuisance; or
  - (I) The licensee, any of its principals, their employees or those acting on their behalf failed to cooperate with the Director's efforts to enforce the provisions of this Code.

### **6.02.340 Disciplinary action—Required or prohibited act violations.**

Whenever this Title requires any act to be done or prohibits or makes unlawful the doing of any act, the failure to do any such required act or the doing of any such prohibited or unlawful act shall subject the person who commits such violation to disciplinary action.

### **6.02.350 Disciplinary action—Acts of principals and subordinates.**

A licensee under this Chapter shall be subject to disciplinary action not only for acts or omissions done by such licensee but also for acts and omissions done by the principals, managers, agents, representatives, servants or employees of such licensee.

### **6.02.360 Disciplinary action—Forms.**

Upon a showing of good cause and in the discretion of the City Council, disciplinary action against a holder may take the form of

cancellation, revocation, refusal to renew, suspension, imposition of conditions or restrictions or civil fine in an amount not to exceed one thousand dollars for each day that the violation which forms the subject matter of the complaint that recommends such disciplinary action is demonstrated to have been in existence, or any combination of such actions, as the particular situation may require. The Council may also impose against the licensee the actual costs incurred, and a reasonable amount for attorney's fees, resulting from the imposition of disciplinary action. The disciplinary actions available in this Section shall be in addition to, and not exclusive of, any other civil or criminal remedy which otherwise might be available.
