**Minutes:**

In his capacity as Administrative Project Specialist, JEFF DIX was tasked with the responsibility of tracking all of the City's utility related issues. As a result of his efforts, a billing error was discovered which subsequently resulted in the City receiving a rebate from the Las Vegas Water District in the amount of \$186,000. MR. DIX, through his enthusiastic effort, has continued to save the City money. One of his most notable endeavors was instituting the waste copper/wire recycling program where those components retrieved from electrical retrofits and rehabilitation projects, were separated, stripped and sent to a recycler. MR. GOODMAN stated that during the past year, this program has provided more than \$0.5 million to the City.

STEVE FORD, Deputy Director of the Field Operations Division, congratulated MR. DIX for the well-deserved recognition. He noted that this position did not exist two years ago and there was no one delegated to oversee all of the City's thousands of utility accounts. Through sheer diligence, determination and investigative measures MR. DIX has succeeded in saving the City thousands of dollars.

MR. DIX expressed his gratitude for the honor of being selected Employee of the Month. He was extremely thankful that the City has allowed him to develop his investigative skills which has resulted in returning money to the General Fund.
