PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

In an effort to generate revenue and remove older parking citations off the books, we are recommending a moratorium program for parking citations. Currently, there is an outstanding balance of \$10,000,000 in parking citations on the books, of which 47% (or \$4,700,000) relates to late fees. By offering this moratorium, citizens should be encouraged to pay their fines knowing penalties, registration holds and boot fees will be removed.
