Minutes:

MAYOR GOODMAN declared the Public Hearing open.

JASON FRAYER, 1181 Greer, appeared on behalf of the applicant and stated the request is to add a 10-foot extension to an existing 60-foot monopole on a Nevada substation. He agreed with staffs recommendations and conditions.

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COUNCILMAN REESE remarked he could support the 10 foot extension as the existing 60-feet is sufficient. MR. PRAYER replied they are limited on what they can do, as there are no other options. COUNCILMAN REESE related that towers keep extending higher and higher making them unsightly.

MAYOR GOODMAN declared the Public Hearing closed.
