Minutes:

MAYOR GOODMAN declared the Public Hearing open for Items 116-119.

MICHAEL VLAOVICH, Public Works, appeared on behalf of the applicant and stated that this project will be a vital part of the trail system along the wash. It will include trail heads and a park.

Regarding Item 118, COUNCILMAN ROSS asked for clarification on the requirement of a cul-de-sac. MR. VLAOVICH explained that it was not going to be a dead end cul-de-sac, but it will continue on a park drive, into the park and out.

CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF: AUGUST 6, 2008

COUNCILMAN REESE explained this is part of the trail park system. Ward 3 will be getting three new parks through Southern Nevada Public Land Act (SNPLA) funds. He verified with MR. VLAOVICH that the project will be done in phases, and the next phase will be the construction, as soon as SNPLA funding is available.
