PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill will repeal obsolete provisions of the Municipal Code relating to the City's representation on the District Board of Health. The membership of the District Board of Health, including City representation, is now governed by NRS 439.362, and the need for Municipal Code provisions on the subject has been eliminated.

Minutes:

CHIEF DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY VAL STEED explained that several years ago, before the State Legislature mandated the makeup of the local Health District, the City had several options as far as appointments to the District Board of Health. Subsequently, a law was enacted designating who would be represented on that Board. Bill No. 2008-35 was proposed to repeal the obsolete provisions of the Municipal Code.

Responding to COUNCILMAN BARLOWS request, CHIEF DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY STEED explained that relative to the Municipal Code, the City would appoint two individuals to the Board. With the enactment of the new law, the Ordinance has become irrelevant and inaccurate.
